Discussion Questions

- 1. Is there someone in your family with whom you are not on good terms? Who is it? What happened? How has this broken relationship affected your life?
- 2. How do you think you would have felt if you were thrown into a pit and sold into slavery by your brothers like Joseph was? How do you think you would react if you ran into someone who hurt you?
- 3. As they say, there are always two sides to every story and Joseph wasn't exactly a saint. Read Genesis 37:1-11. What did he do to agitate his brothers? What would have been a better way for him to handle the situation? What does this teach us about how we relate to those around us?
- 4. We learned from Joseph's story that God is with us; He wants us to face our brokenness; He is in control; He wants us to confess and forgive; and He wants to heal our brokenness. Which of these truths from Joseph's story resonated with you the most?
